Directions – Carpooling Recommended!

- **From I-10**– Exit East on Ray Road. Drive approximately 1 mile and turn left (north) on Beck Avenue. Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane. Park in either parking lot or on the street.
- **From US-60** – Connect to I-10 East and follow the directions above.
- **From Loop 101 (Price Rd)** – Exit West on Ray Road. Drive approximately 3.5 miles and turn right (north) on Beck Avenue. Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane. Park in either parking lot or on the street.
- **From Loop 202 (Pecos Rd)** – Exit North on Kyrene Road. Drive approximately 2 miles and turn left (west) on Ray Road. Turn right on Beck Avenue and Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane. Park in either parking lot or on the street.

Room location – After parking, follow the signs directing you to registration.
