Directions – Carpooling Recommended!

- **From I-10**– Exit East on Elliot Road. Drive approximately 4 miles and turn left (north) on Lakeshore. Ninos School will be straight ahead at the end of the street where it curves to the right and turns into Dava Dr. There will be several parking lots in the area as well as street parking.
- **From US-60** –Exit South on Rural. Drive approximately 3 miles and turn east- left onto Elliot and north-Left onto Lakeshore. Ninos School will be straight ahead at the end of the street where it curves to the right and turns into Dava Dr..Or you can exit McClintock and head south approx. 2 miles and turn right on Dava Dr. travel approx. ½ mile to the school which will be on the north side of the street.
- **From Loop 101 (Price Rd)** – Exit West on Elliot Road. Drive approximately 1.5 miles and turn right-north onto onto Lakeshore. Ninos School will be straight ahead at the end of the street where it curves to the right and turns into Dava Dr.

Room location – After parking, follow the signs directing you to registration.
