#### Directions – Carpooling Recommended!

• **From I-10 Maricopa Freeway:** Exit East on Ray Road. Drive approximately 1 mile and turn left (north) on Beck Avenue. Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane.

• **From Loop 101 Price Freeway:** Exit West on Ray Road. Drive approximately 3.5 miles and turn right (north) on Beck Avenue. Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane.

• **From US-60 Superstition Freeway:** Connect to I-10 East or Loop 101 South and follow the directions above.

• **From Loop 202 San Tan Freeway:** Exit North on Kyrene Road. Drive approximately 2 miles and turn left (west) on Ray Road. Turn right on Beck Avenue and Manitas School will be on your right at Courtney Lane.

**Parking and Room Location:** Park in either parking lot or on the street. After parking, follow the signs directing you to registration.
